O'Malley is Going to the Dogs!

The O'Malley Alley Cat Organization is pleased to announce O'Malley P.E.T. (Preventing Euthanasia Together). O'Malley is officially expanding its work from cats only, to include cats and dogs, as we respond to need in our community. As some of you may know, SpayNeuterNac, a low cost spay-neuter clinic beginning in 2009, was closed in April of this year. Many of the SpayNeuterNac clinic volunteers were also O'Mallians, and we have come together to continue the important work. As euthanasias of homeless dogs and cats at our shelter are unacceptably high, a low cost spay-neuter clinic is sorely needed for the pets and people of Nacogdoches county, and the surrounding area.

We are now holding fundraisers and applying for grants to secure funds needed to procure needed equipment and supplies to resume our work. Facilities, equipment and
